

EXTERIOR RODENT TREATMENT

Exterior Treatment Client Preparation Form



In order to ensure we deliver the most effective treatment possible, we ask you to please follow the instructions outlined in this sheet. Following these steps will ensure our technicians are able to perform safe and effective treatments to fully eliminate the pests at hand.

HOW TO PREPARE FOR THE SERVICE



Keep Pets Inside

Please have all pets inside the home while the technician is working outside. All rodent baits are placed in tamper proof locked stations which ensures no pets can access the baits inside. Once the technician has finished, you can let pets outside.



Dispose of Garbage

To aid in the effectiveness of your exterior rodent treatment, please remove any and all garbage in the yard. Please keep garbage properly sealed in bags in the appropriate containers. This will eliminate competing food sources and keep treatment effective. Additionally, please keep all food bags, feed bags, and seed bags completely sealed and off the ground.



Identify areas of activity

If you have particular areas of concern you would like addressed, please notify our technician at the time of service or the office prior to your appointment. If you are unsure, our technician will complete a thorough property inspection to identify all activity and treat accordingly.



Cut Grass Short

Rodents love when grass is long, it provides shelter and plenty of food. To aid in the effectiveness of your exterior rodent treatment, we recommend keeping grass cut short.

AFTER THE TREATMENT

The rodent interior treatment **will only remain effective** if the following after treatment steps are taken and followed in your residence once the treatment is complete:

- **DO NOT** use other pest control products, this will greatly decrease the effectiveness of the treatment or may entirely eliminate the treatment.
- **DO NOT** move any of the rodent control stations or traps set out by our technician.
- Follow recommendations given by our technician for any repairs or cleaning that may be required.
- **Remove all food sources.** This means you must keep all food in tightly sealed containers, clean up any spills, remove trash on a regular basis from the property.

REMINDER

It is not necessary for you or your pets to leave during the treatment. Please ensure someone is home at the time of service to allow access to areas that require treatment.

- Please be patient, this treatment will **REDUCE rodent activity** to very low levels within approximately 2-4 weeks leading to elimination over a period of time.
- Our technicians develop specialized treatments for each individual case for our clients, please follow all recommendations and guidelines set out by our technicians during the treatment period.

WHAT TO EXPECT FROM THE TREATMENT

Your technician starts by completing a full exterior inspection of your home to identify any and all possible rodent activity and nesting sites. Once identified, our technician may provide recommendations on how to reduce rodent activity in addition to this treatment. Your technician may set out

rodent bait stations, mechanical traps, or burrow bait depending on what they deem the best course of treatment. Extreme caution and safety concern is used when installing any type of rodent control measures at your home. All baits are placed in tamper resistant rodent stations. These stations will be placed in inaccessible locations (to people and pets whenever possible).
